



Vincentian Scholars

The Vincentian Scholar Award is awarded to incoming freshmen who have achieved and maintained a GPA of 4.0 in all disciplines during his or her 7th and 8th grade year and has met all the requirements of the award. As the patron saint of our school, St. Vincent de Paul exhibited humility, faith, kindness, intellect and respect for those less fortunate. His humbleness and devotion to his faith are qualities we also look for in a Vincentian Scholar.

Eligibility

- Scholar achieved all A's (4.0) during scholar's 7th and 8th grade academic years.
- Placed in the top 10% of the high school placement test no later than January 8, 2022.
- Scholar applied to St. Vincent de Paul High School no later than November 1, 2021.

The Process

- Eligible scholars will be notified of eligibility by the Admissions Office by January 18, 2022.
- Required to submit the following parts of the application by 5:00 p.m. February 18, 2022.
 1. Essays to multiple questions.
 2. A letter of recommendation from their principal, priest (or other religious leader), or a leading member of their local community who is familiar with the applicant.
 3. Based on essays and letter of recommendation, the Vincentian Committee will select applicants and their families to participate in Vincentian interviews in early March. Applicants will be required to wear business attire for the interview.

Scholar applicants will be notified of the results on March 1, 2022. Scholars and parents will sign an agreement detailing the requirements of the award. The benefits include **one-half tuition for all four years**, including **class registration priority** and **college counseling** beginning in freshman year. Scholars enjoy membership in the Alumni Professional Mentor Group and are eligible for field trips to a wide range of businesses including healthcare, law, finance, environmental planning, and professional sports management.

Maintenance of Award

A Vincentian Scholar must maintain a weighted cumulative GPA of 3.5 or higher during his/her four years of attendance at St. Vincent de Paul High School. If a scholar falls below a GPA of 3.5, the scholar risks loss of the award. Vincentian Scholars must complete 50 hours of community service per year and maintain a flawless discipline record. We have high expectations of our Vincentian Scholars. The award may be rescinded for violations of any Student Handbook policies including excessive tardiness or absences.
