### **Program Description**

St. Vincent de Paul Student Ambassadors are students who demonstrate leadership characteristics within the school community, are academically successful and have a genuine desire to work with prospective students to share why SVHS is the best choice for them. - Stay available and supportive of assigned mentees for the school year.

- Minimum of a 2.5 GPA with no major disciplinary issues.
- Must be a 10th, 11th or 12th grade student in the 2023-24 school year.

- Strong work ethic and ability to handle responsibility.

- Enthusiastic and positive attitude.
- A sincere desire to be a consistent resource for peers.
- A sincere desire to help SVHS foster a positive school reputation.
