### COMMUNITY SERVICE

### ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT CLASS OF 2023

The average Weighted GPA in the class of 2023 was 3.76, with a high GPA of 4.57 from a class of 42 students

### EXPLANATION OF RANKING, AP LIMITS ETC.

- A D grade is considered passing for graduation.
- Failed courses remediated at SVDP cannot receive a grade higher than a C. Courses remediated outside of SVDP are not replaced on the transcript but added as an additional course.
- The honors and AP courses, which are significantly more demanding, are weighted with one additional point.
- Students are limited to three AP courses per semester.
- Only 2 AP courses are available to students prior to Junior year.
- SVDP does NOT rank students
- Students may not take dual enrollment courses for subjects offered at SVDP
