COMMUNITY SERVICE

In 2025, 36% of our graduates received St. Vincent de Paul Community Service Medals for completing 200-500 Community Service hours.

ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT CLASS OF 2025

The average Weighted GPA in the class of 2025 was 3.62, with a high GPA of 4.51 from a class of 39 students.

EXPLANATION OF RANKING, AP LIMITS ETC.

- A D grade is considered passing for graduation.
- Failed courses remediated at SV during the summer cannot receive a grade higher than a C. Courses remediated outside of SV for D and F grades are not replaced on the transcript, but added as an additional course. Remediation of C grades must be done outside SV and are not added to SV transcripts.
- The honors and AP courses, which are significantly more demanding, are weighted with one additional point.
- Students are limited to three AP courses per semester.
- Only 2 AP courses are available to students prior to Junior year.
- SV does NOT rank students.
- Students may not take dual enrollment courses for subjects offered at SV without special circumstances.
